- g. Enter Password and download article

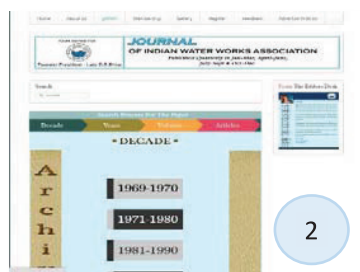

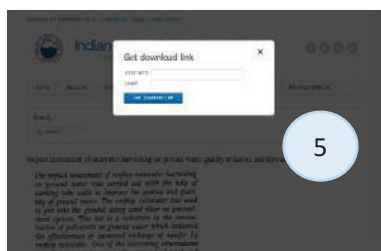

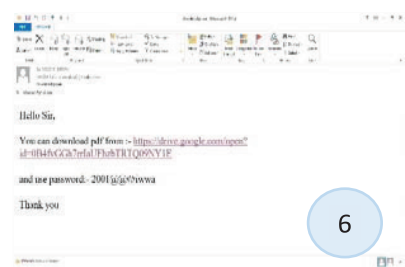
